A fun occurrence captured by the artist's brush, one of these sweet moments we know will remain in these lovers' minds. The same loving couple we will find in a room filled with flowers, embraced in front of a large window overlooking the city, exchanging a passionate kiss.

Life has so much to offer, we must savour the best of it, tells us each of Lise Lacaille's paintings, whatever their themes may be: family or restaurant scenes, sunsets or city outings. One cannot help but smile and feel what the painted characters are feeling. Without

hesitation we must follow the lady in red – such a joyous vivid colour, symbol of life and energy, which warms and rejoices us and so readily expresses what the artist attempts to communicate.
